

Short Biography:

Dr Svetlana Galitzine, MD ("Vrach"), DEAA, FRCA, EDRA

Dr Svetlana Vladimirovna Galitzine (formerly Rutter) is Consultant Anaesthetist in the Nuffield Department of Anaesthetics, Oxford University NHS Hospitals Trust and Honorary Senior Clinical Lecturer, University of Oxford. Graduated and qualified as an anaesthesiologist in Ekaterinburg, Russia. Completed anaesthetic training in the UK: DA (1993), DEAA (1994), FRCA (1997). Gained EDRA (2008) by examination.

Since Consultant appointment, areas of particular clinical and research interests include anaesthesia for major and reconstructive orthopaedic and orthoplastic surgery, patients' reported outcomes of regional anaesthesia, central neuraxial anaesthesia with conscious sedation for prolonged orthoplastic surgery, audio-visual distraction as an adjunct to regional anaesthesia, standardised documentation and other safety issues in RA. An invited speaker nationally and internationally; presenter of some 50 tutorials and lectures; author of several peer-reviewed publications and of over 60 papers presented at national, European and World congresses.

ESA examiner and former member of the ESA examiners' committee; past member and Treasurer of the RA-UK Board; EDRA examiner and member of the ESRA Diploma Board; member of the ESRA Scientific Committee.

Lead for regional anaesthesia advanced training and orthopaedic & regional anaesthesia higher training in Oxford School of Anaesthesia. Initiator, co-organiser of and faculty at more than 30 educational courses and meetings in and outside UK, including annual 2-day Oxford Regional Anaesthesia Course with Cadaveric Anatomy workshop and the RA-UK Cadaveric Anatomy Courses. Taught at over 40 small group workshops. Co-organiser of the 2015 RA-UK annual scientific meeting (national Regional Anaesthesia Society) and the forthcoming autumn 2016 B.S.O.A annual scientific meeting (British Society of Orthopaedic Anaesthetists), both hosted in Oxford.
