ANNOUNCEMENT: 6TH INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM OF THE WORLD FEDERATION OF NEUROSURGICAL SOCIETIES (WFNS) SYMPOSIA 2018

We would like to share with you the good news that Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia have been given the honour of hosting the **6th International Symposium of the World Federation of Neurosurgical Societies (WFNS) Symposia 2018**. The dates for this conference is **15th to 16th August 2018 (Pre-Symposia Workshops)** and **17th to 19th August 2018 (Full Day Symposia)**. One of the key areas of the meeting will focus on the development of young neurosurgeons. In line with the focus of our meeting, we, the Host is providing **100 Young NeuroSurgeon Education Grant**. Suitable candidates will be awarded the grant, based on a few criteria, one of which includes how good their abstract scores against all others that are submitted. If you can please list our conference on your association website, our conference secretariat will be able to send to you the necessary artwork for your website promotion.

We have not forgotten the more established and experienced neurosurgeons. Our scientific committee is lining up an exciting and educational programme which will consist of Lectures and Plenaries delivered by Authorities and Eminent Speakers from Member Societies and Affiliates of the WFNS. There will also be no less than six (6) 2-day pre-symposia workshops ranging from cadaveric workshop to lab rat neurovascular workshops which will encourage hands-on learning. However, these pre-symposia workshops will have limited places. The planning is in progress and once it is up, we will share this information with you and in the conference website.

Our organising committee is also planning an unforgettable time in Kuala Lumpur as meetings are not just about scientific learning and case sharing, but of building fellowships and renewing friendships.
