He is Leading Guest Editor of a Special Issue on US-Elastography for EJR and on CEUS already published in EJR

Research interest mainly focused on US contrast media in abdominal and non-abdominal applications in correlation with multislice-CT and enhanced-MRI and US-elastography mainly in thyroid, testicle, liver, breast, salivary glands.
