

Prof. Odd Helge Gilja, MD, Ph.D (Norway)

Odd Helge Gilja is currently Director and Senior Consultant at National Centre for Ultrasound in Gastroenterology at Haukeland University Hospital, Bergen. He is also Professor at University of Bergen and current President of EFSUMB.



Odd Helge Gilja received his medical degree from University of Bergen in 1988 and did his Ph.D. in 1997 in Bergen. He specialised in internal medicine and gastroenterology at Haukeland University Hospital, Bergen. He was appointed Professor in Medicine in 2002. He has supervised 18 PhD candidates. He serves on the Editorial Board of 6 journals. He has received 6 international prizes and obtained The Gheorge Badea Medal for outstanding achievements in the development and promotion of ultrasonography in Romania.

He was president of the Norwegian Society for Diagnostic Ultrasound in Medicine from 2001 to 2007. He has been chairman of EFSUMB's Education and Professional Standards Committee and Honorary Secretary of EFSUMB. He is member of WFUMB's Sponsorship committee since 2013. He is Editor of 7 books and is author of 280 scientific papers and book chapters, and well as 60 popular science publications.
